Guidance notes (please keep a copy of this page for your reference)

- 1. There is a one-off payment of £3.00 per adult for all preliminary competitions (prelims) and the finals. All children go in free.
- 2. The finals are on Sat.March 25th at 9.00 a.m. in King Henry VIII School, Abergavenny.
- 3. Music competitors must supply 2 copies of music (original and copy) for accompanist and adjudicator, with competitor's name and competition no. on the music.
- If a competitor needs an accompanist please send music to R. Williams (below) by 7th March.
- 5. Recitation competitors must bring 2 copies of the piece with them for the adjudicator and organiser.
- 6. Songs or recitations can be in English or Welsh; there are no set pieces.
- 7. Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult.
- 8. Photographs will be taken and may be used for publicity purposes.
- 9. Conductors and accompanists may be adults or children.
- Material used in songs and dance must be suitable for children; competitors will be disqualified if not.
- 11. There is a 3 minute limit for competitions; marks are deducted if entries go over time.
